The Malaya Oktyabrskaya Railway



The movement of trains on the Malaya Oktyabrskaya railway was opened on August 27, 1948. The road began from the place where the Metro station "Old Village" is now located and went to the Shuvalovo train station. The length of the road was 8 km 100 m. There were 3 stations on the road: Kirovskaya, Zoo, and Ozernaya. There were three locomotives and nine wooden passenger cars on the road. There were eight crossings the road - three guarded and five unguarded; there was a bridge over the Black River.



In 1965, due to the construction of the city, the road was reduced to 3 km 100 m, there were 3 stations: Ozernaya, Young, and Pionerskaya. On the road there were 5 diesel locomotives and 10 passenger cars, 2 crossings, equipped with automatic

barriers. A reconstruction was carried out on the road. Now the road was equipped with a modern, for those times, semi-automatic blockings.



In 1991, the road was again reduced, 2 stations remained on it: Ozernaya and Yuny, the length of the road decreased to 2 km. On the road there were 3 diesel locomotives and 10 passenger cars. The Southern route of the Malaya Oktyabrskaya railway was opened on 12 July 2011. The Railway runs 10.5 km and it has 3 stations Razezd Yunyi, Molodezhnaya and Tsarskoselskaya. The road is equipped with modern alarm and communication systems. The railway has 3 diesel locomotives, 11 passenger cars, and since 2015 a restored steam locomotive.



There are also two bridges over the Volkovka River and the Kuzminka River, and a depot for the rolling stock. On the Children's railway, there are 4 shifts of young railway workers - about 1,400 people. Each shift runs on specific days and hours. Different excursions to railway enterprises are organised for children in free time. Children of 5 -7 grades can attend railway road course. The duration of the course is 5 years. Classes, for an hour each, are held once a week from October to April in the educational building of the Malaya Oktyabrskaya Railway. In the summer, children practice on routes.

Even before the start of a large tourist influx Boulevard loved by the locals, but now they are very rare to be found in the many-sided mass of walking guests.
